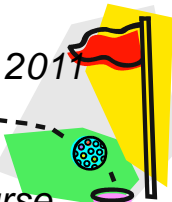

**BY LAW CHANGES PROPOSED TO THE AERIE**

*THE BY LAWS COMMITTEE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OF THE BY LAWS TO THE AERIE.*

*Introduced to aerie: 6/22/2011, First Reading: 7/13/2011, Second Reading: 7/27/2011, Final Reading, Discussion and Vote by Aerie: 8/10/2011.*

**NEW ADDITION:**

**PRELUDE:** *In the By-Laws the use of Masculine Gender, where appropriate includes Feminine and the use of Singular included Plural.*

**Existing**

*SECTION 3.1 The fee for membership by initiation shall be \$20.00.*

**CHANGE 3.1 TO READ:**

*SECTION 3.1 The fee for membership by initiation shall be \$30.00*

**Existing**

*SECTION 4.1 The following funds are hereby established for this Aerie: (a) The Benefit Fund (b)The General Fund (c) The Gambling/Social Fund (d) The building Maintenance Fund (e) Trustees Petty Cash Fund. (It will consist of a checking account and a cash box for Social Room operation)*

**CHANGE 4.1 TO READ:**

*SECTION 4.1 The following funds are hereby established for this Aerie: (a) The Benefit Fund (b) The General Fund (c) The Gambling/Social Fund (d) The building Maintenance Fund (e) Social Room Management Fund. (It will consist of a checking account and a cash box for Social Room operation)*

**Existing**

*SECTION 5.1.1 Dues of existing beneficial members shall be \$41.00 per year, payable in advance.*

**CHANGE 5.1.1 TO READ:**

*SECTION 5.1.1 Dues of existing beneficial members shall be \$51.00 per year, payable in advance.*

**Existing**

*SECTION 5.3 Dues of non-beneficial members shall be \$35.00 per year, payable in advance.*

**CHANGE 5.3 TO READ:**

*SECTION 5.3 Dues of non-beneficial members shall be \$45.00 per year, payable in advance.*

**NEW SECTION 9.0**

*All Increases in wages of employees whose salaries are not stipulated by our By Laws must be approved by the Board of Trustees and sanctioned by majority vote of the Aerie Members in attendance at a regular meeting*

**SECTIONS 9.1, 9.3, 9.5, 9.7,** *change the word "shall "to "may".*

**Existing**

*SECTION 9.6 For faithful performance of duties, the Secretary of the Board of Trustees if he desires will receive the sum of \$250.00 per month.*

**CHANGE 9.6**

*SECTION 9.6 For faithful performance of his duties, the Secretary of the Board of Trustees may receive the sum of \$250.00 per month.*

**Existing**

*SECTION 9.8.2 Christmas bonuses are at the discretion of the Board of Trustees and will be considered at the first meeting in December each year.*

**CHANGE 9.8.2 TO READ:**

*SECTION 9.8.2 Christmas bonuses are at the discretion of the Board of Trustees and may be considered at the first meeting in December each year.*

**Existing**

*SECTION 9.9 When ever the Aerie, by properly adopted resolution, sends its accredited representatives to the Grand Aerie convention, the Washington state convention, they may be allowed as their expenses, seventy five dollars (\$75.00) per day while in attendance at the sessions, plus their registration fee.*

**CHANGE 9.9 TO READ:**

*SECTION 9.9 When ever the Aerie, by properly adopted resolution, sends its accredited representatives to the Grand Aerie convention, the Washington state convention, they may be allowed as their expenses, seventy five dollars (\$75.00) per day while in attendance at the sessions, (must attend all sessions to receive compensation), plus their registration fee.*

*SECTION 11.4 The Board of Trustees with the approval of the Aerie may delegate the operation of the kitchen to the Ladies Auxiliary.*

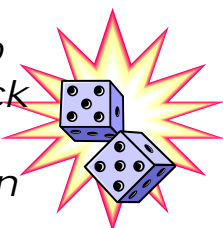
Did you know we have a new Happy Hour? From 5pm-8pm save 25cents on any cocktail.

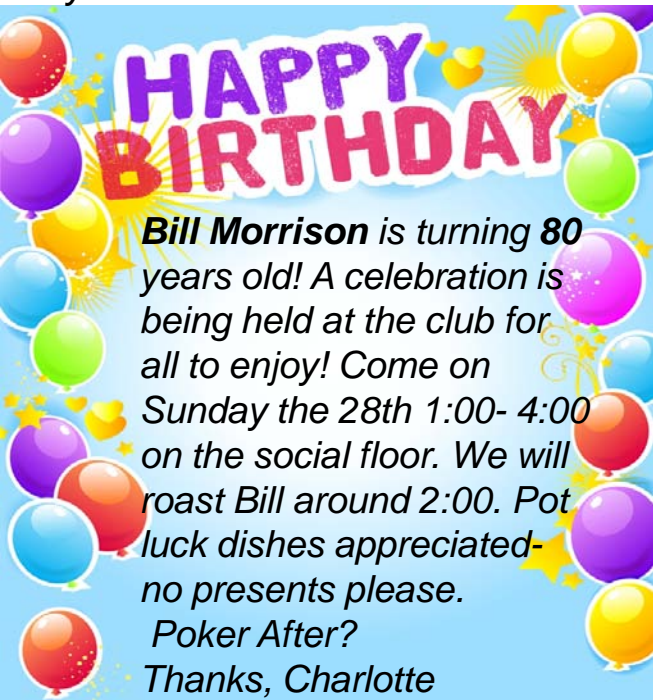

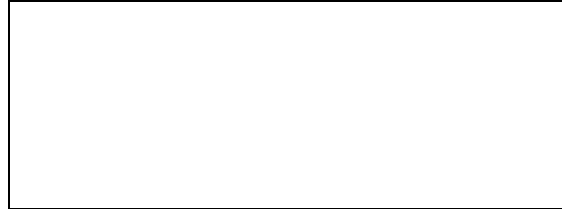
